FORMAT OF PLAY

A. Regional Qualifying Tournaments for Indonesian Players

1. There shall be 4 Region Final events and each Region Final will be attended by 32 (or 64) players who are winners from various pool centers Preliminary Tournaments to be held in the nearby cities weekends preceding the Region Final.
2. Most Preliminary Tournaments are 32 draw with a few events on 16 or 64 draw, all on single knock-out format, all matches race to 7. Top winners from the Preliminary Tournaments in various pool centers will comprise of the players field to the Region Final.
3. Open to all Indonesian players, repeat entries will only be allowed if vacancies are still available
4. Region Final - 32 players to play on single knock-out format, alternate break, all matches race to 7.
5. Top winners from each Region Final will advance to World Series of Pool Grand Finals main event in Jakarta and their travel & accommodations will be hosted by Guinness.

B. Qualifying events for Overseas Players

1. There shall be 5 spots for overseas players to qualify.
2. The qualifying events will be held in a selected pool center during July 9-11.
3. Qualifying tournaments are 32 draw, all on single knock-out format, all matches race to 7. Winner will advance to World Series of Pool Grand Finals main event in Jakarta.
4. Open to all overseas players. Multiple entries will only be allowed if vacancies are still available.

C. Main Event in Jakarta

1. Total 64 players (34 Indonesian players and 30 invited/seeded overseas professional players.)
2. 34 Indonesian players comprise of :
 - 4 POBSI players
 - 10 Central Region finals (Jakarta, Bandung, Cirebon, Bekasi)
 - 6 East Region finals (Surabaya, Bali, Malang, Solo, Jogjakarta, Semarang)
 - 6 West Region finals (Medan, Pekanbaru, Batam, Jambi, Lampung,)
 - 6 North Region finals (Makassar, Sorong, Pontianak, Manado, Palu, Ambon, etc.)
 - 2 Organiser Invited players (incl. Ricky Yang & Irsal Nasution)
3. 30 invited/professional players comprise of: (To be finalised)
 - 1 defending champion
 - 6 from APBU
 - 6 from America
 - 6 from Europe
 - 5 from Qualifying
 - 6 invited by organizer

If any of the above quota are not filled up, the remaining quota will become wildcard entries to be decided by organiser
4. Men's 10 ball competition with 64 players to play on double elimination, race to 6.
5. Top 32 players then play on single knock out format, race to 8.
6. Final match race to 10.

Entry conditions:

- A. All Players will need to sign up entry forms to confirm acceptance of all terms and conditions and pay applicable entry fees.
- B. All players will agree to wear event uniforms and proper attires at Region Finals and World Series Main Event
- C. All players will agree to attend press conference / players meeting / draw and fun games/clinics and media interviews as advised by Event Organiser.
- D. All players shall not wear any beer branding that may conflict to the Title sponsor during the event period.
- E. All players must be age 18 years and above.

Deadline: 3 weeks before each qualifying tournaments (first come first served)
Entry Fees: Entry fee will be charged for only Rp100,000 (or USD11) to enter the tournament qualifiers.
